What is Big Steps to Success?

- Big Steps 2 Success (BS2S) is a one-on-one mentoring program for youth, aged 7-14, who are living in government care.
- Young people are mentored by trained volunteers who can help them to navigate challenges and empower them to realize their full potential.
- Youth and their mentors meet once per week for 2-4 hours, sharing their interests with free to low-cost activities. Youth and mentors can meet either in the community or at the young person's school.

Who are our Mentors?

- Big Brothers Big Sisters mentors complete thorough screening and undergo training focused on building, maintaining and growing developmental relationships with children and youth.
- BS2S mentors receive additional training about the specific needs and experiences of youth in care.
